

Queens' MCR Fresher's Week Guide 2017

Details of the events and locations
(Mandatory in bold).



Tuesday the 26th of September: If you are arriving early, join us for a welcoming reception in the *Woodville Room* from 5pm to 6pm, followed by dinner in *Cripps Hall*, and then a pub trip to *The Eagle* from 7:30pm.

Thursday 28th of September: Collect room keys at the *Porter's Lodge (PLodge)* on Silver Street, and check your pigeon hole- the source of much information throughout your time at Queens! Join us at 7pm at the *PLodge* from where we will leave for the *Anchor Pub* opposite the Mathematical Bridge for the *welcome event* – after 7pm just come to *the Anchor*.



Friday 29th of September: The **Graduate Tutors' Welcome Lunch buffet** is served from **12:00**, in *QBar/conservatory*, followed by a **welcome presentation** by the graduate tutors, college staff, and MCR President from **1pm** in the *Fitzpatrick Hall*. From **2:15pm**, **sign the Matriculation Register, meet the President**, Lord Eatwell, in the *President's Lodge*, and collect your University Card. Following this, **afternoon tea** will be served in the *President's garden* until **4:15pm**, (or *Old Hall* in poor weather). From 5:45 to 7pm, dinner is in *Cripps Hall*, as is normal for term time; the *MCR Drinks Reception* will be held in *The Armitage Room* from 8pm, with formal dress code*.

Saturday 30th of September: *College Brunch* is served from 11am to 1:30pm in *Cripps Hall* on Saturdays, and the *MCR Coffee morning and "grad buddy" Q&A session* will run concurrently in *QBar/conservatory*. This is your opportunity to meet your 'grad buddy', a continuing member of the MCR studying a subject close to yours, who can answer questions surrounding your subject, course & college. A *tour of Queens'* will take place at 1:30pm and a *practical tour of Cambridge* at 2:15pm, both leaving from outside the *Woodville Room*. The tour will end at *Ryder & Amies*, where gowns are sold (required for the matriculation photo and dinner). From 3pm to 6pm, there will be *MCR Punting* in 1-hour slots, using the college punts moored outside the *Woodville room*. The *MCR Quiz* will start post-dinner at 7:30pm in *QBar* (both alcoholic and non-alcoholic drinks are available). At 11pm, we will leave *QBar* for a *night out in Cambridge*.

Sunday 1st of October: A *Granchester Meadows run* will leaving from the *Owlstone croft gate* at 10am. *Brunch* is from 11am to 1:30pm. From 11am to 1pm, individual portrait photos are taken on *Erasmus Lawn*. Appointment slots can be reserved in advance, see the GFI pack on the college website for reservation details - <http://www.queens.cam.ac.uk/apply-to-queens/graduates/graduate-fresher-information-pack>. At **1:30pm**, the **matriculation photo** is taken (formal dress code* with gowns) in *Walnut Tree Court*, followed by a **mixer event** in *Cripps Hall* from **2pm**, the **Queens' Scavenger Hunt** at **3:15pm**, and **Subject Cluster Groups and Refreshments** from **4pm** in the *Old Hall & Old Kitchens*. A *trip to The Mill* will leave from the *PLodge* at 8pm, and proceed to the *Eagle*: Crick & Watson's favourite.

Monday 2nd of October: 20 minute *Queens' Library tour* at either 10am or 2pm: includes introductions to catalogues, e-resources, and the self-issue system. *Lunch* is served in *Cripps Hall* from 12:30 to 2pm. From 2:30 to 3:30, *Queens' boat club Squash* (party/reception to introduce people to the club) will be held in *Fitzpatrick Hall*, and from 3:30pm to 6pm, the *Societies Squash* will take place, in *Lyon Court (Fitzpatrick Hall if raining)*. At 7pm, *introduction to the Cambridge Library System* will be held with the librarian in *CC43 (Cripps Court)*, covering e-resources and collections. In the evening, from 8pm, a *buffet/barbeque* will be held at *Owlstone Croft*, with taxis organised from college houses.

Tuesday 3rd of October: 20 minute *Queens' Library tour* at either 10am or 2pm. At 3pm, *introduction to the Cambridge Library System* will be held with the librarian in *CC43 (Cripps Court)*. At 5:45pm, there is a *pre-dinner service* in the *chapel*, for those who wish to attend, followed by the **matriculation dinner** from **6:45**, in *Fitzpatrick Hall* and *Cripps Hall* (dress code as for *matric. photo*). After the **matriculation dinner**, there will be a *Bar Night* in *QBar*.

Wednesday 4th of October: 20 minute *Queens' Library tour* at either 10am or 2pm. Trips to the *University Freshers' Fair* will depart from the *PLodge* at 10am and 11am (it's also held on Tuesday the 3rd). At 3pm, *introduction to the Cambridge Library System* will be held with the librarian in *CC43 (Cripps Court)*. After dinner, a non-alcoholic celebration of *Mid-Autumn Day* will be held in the *Bowett Room* from 8pm, whilst the *Cambridge MCR Bar Crawl* will depart from *QBar* at 7:45- a great opportunity to see other bars in Cambridge, and socialise!

* **Formal Dress Code:** For men, typically a lounge suit & tie, whilst for women, whatever they feel is appropriate, but typically a dress ranging in length from just above the knee to 2 inches above the ankle. Gowns are required for formals/matriculation dinner.



Thursday 5th of October: 20 minute *Queens' Library tour* at either 10am or 2pm. The first *MCR Formal* of term will be held in *Cripps Hall*, with drinks from 6:45pm in the *Woodville Room* or *QBar*. Sign up and pay on UPAY; the dress code is formal* (Gowns also required).

Friday 6th of October: The *MCR Party* will be held from 8pm in the *Woodville Room*, concurrently to an optional QEnts (JCR) Tripos-themed *Bop*- tickets are available to purchase on the door.

Saturday 7th of October: *Brunch* from 11am to 1:30pm will be followed by the famous *Granchester Walk*, as pictured, departing from the *PLodge* at 2pm.

Wander along the Cam to *Granchester Orchard*, where you may partake in *afternoon tea*. A *Grad Choir Concert* will be held from 6pm, location TBC, and *LGBT+ welcome drinks* will be held in the *Woodville Room* from 7pm.

Sunday 8th of October: *Brunch* from 11am to 1:30pm will be followed by a *PhD Q&A session* in the *Woodville Room* from 2 to 3:30pm. A *trip to the Fitzwilliam Museum and/or Botanic Gardens*, will depart from the *PLodge* at 3:30. Join us for an exploration of history, art, and plants! *Evensong* will take place in the chapel from 6pm followed by a *drinks reception* with the Dean of Chapel (all welcome to attend). *MCR wine and cheese* (& non-alcoholic option) will start at 8pm in *Old Hall*, with formal* or Black Tie dress code.



Monday 9th of October/Tuesday 10th of October: From 6:30 to 7:30pm- **Drinks Reception** in the *President's Lodge* (a personal invitation will be emailed to you, with the relevant date).
