## FOREWARD AND FINANCIAL OUTLOOK

The MCR committee accounts faced an uncertain future after a handover was conducted late and in disarray, under the looming shadow of an uncertain number of invoices from Cambridge Wine Merchants and catering. The credit cards arrived in the nick of time for Fresher's Week. This year we have strived and struggled to live within our means as the BREXIT effect was combined with a weak pound and striking ambitions from ENTS and the rest of the committee, as the MCR programme saw yet another year-on-year dramatic expansion. Some costs were shifted effectively over to the Senior Bursar and the SCR, including the bill for MCR-SCR Talks nibbles and drinks, which has increased alarmingly since the fellows started to attend in force.

The MCR Treasurer was supported strongly in her role as she bravely improved the balance sheet, and gave the MCR the leverage, freedom and confidence to spend as was necessary to create strong community. Over the year, the MCR Treasury under the strong, competent and dedicated leadership of Ms Hartwell has delivered regular budgets to communicate the financial challenges, met our obligations with the college and other debtors, regularly paid in funds accrued from activities, and finally brought the MCR into line with rigorous accounting procedures. Every expenditure has been scrutinised with precision and care, revealing the strategic risks faced by ENTS and the Stewards, and the enormous turnover.
